Big Bang™ Hybrid Coreopsis

Coreopsis hybrid

Family: Asteraceae

Stem & Leaf Type: herbaceous perennial
Size: 12-18" tall x 12-36" wide
USDA Hardiness Zones: 5
Leaves : narrow, varies from entire to deeply lobed
Leaf Color: medium to dark green
Fall Color: yellow or brown
Flower Time: June to frost
Flower Color: yellow, red, pink, white, bicolor
Fruit: not ornamental
Light: Full sun is best, leggy in partial shade
Moisture: well-drained to dry
Insect/Disease Issues: none significant
Nativity: hybridized in Hubbardston, Mass
Location in the Gardens:
 Hillside Garden

Culture & Landscape Value: A series of hybrids that brought new colors and large flower sizes to the genus *Coreopsis*. Cultivars include 'Cosmic Evolution' (white with pink streaks), 'Cosmic Eye' (Red and yellow), 'Full Moon' (canary yellow), 'Galaxy' (semi-double yellow), 'Mercury Rising' (solid dark red), 'Star Cluster' (white with red eye), and 'Redshift' (yellow to red flowers, each slightly different). Good for using in borders and perennial bed.
