Abies concolor

Family: Pinaceae

Stem & Leaf Type: evergreen tree

Size: 50' tall x 30' wide

USDA Hardiness Zones: 4-7

Leaves : Flat, glaucous 1.5-2.5" needles that curve outward and upward.

Leaf Color: bluish-green

Fall Color: none

Flower Time: Non-flowering
